Geriatric psychiatrists often face refractory illness in their patients with mood disorders, anxiety, and behavioral disturbances in dementia, and can find themselves at a loss for a clinical approach when the recommended treatments fail. Attendees at this conference will be encouraged to consider their own experiences with treatment-resistance in their patients, and will learn from the expertise of international experts in geriatric psychiatry.

A combination of keynote presentations, symposia and smaller-group workshops will enhance opportunities to learn strategies for treating older patients with difficult-to-treat mental illness.
