Dr. Blumberger completed his medical school training at the University of Toronto where he also completed his residency training in psychiatry. He completed a Research Fellowship in Brain Stimulation and Geriatric Psychiatry at the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health. He is certified as a sub-specialist in Geriatric Psychiatry. He has been a board member of the CAGP since 2013 and Chair of the Annual Scientific Meeting since 2014. He is the Medical Head and Co-Director of the Temerty Centre for Therapeutic Brain Intervention. His research focuses on the use of brain stimulation therapies for refractory psychiatric disorders. His main research focuses on novel treatments and understanding the neurophysiology of treatment resistant depression across the lifespan. He is the principal investigator or co-investigator on numerous clinical trials using different brain stimulation modalities including: magnetic seizure therapy (MST), repetitive transcranial magnetic stimulation (rTMS), deep rTMS and transcranial direct current stimulation (tDCS).
