## Yves Joanette PhD, FCAHS



Yves Joanette is Professor of Cognitive Neurosciences and Aging at the Faculty of Medicine of the Université de Montréal. He is currently the Scientific Director of the Institute of Aging of the Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR). He is the scientific lead of the CIHR dementia research strategy and act as co-lead of other initiatives on eHealth and on Healthy and Productive Work. Yves Joanette is also overseing the CIHR Canadian Longitudinal Study on Aging. He sits on many international advisory and management boards, including European initiatives in which Canada participates. Yves Joanette is Member of the Steering Committee of the Joint Programming Initiative – More, Better

Lives, Member of the Centre for the Future of Aging of the Milken Institute and was recently elected Chair of the World Dementia Council.

Yves Joanette has been Scholar and Scientist of the Canadian Medical Research Council and has received many distinctions, including the André-Dupont Award, and the Eve-Kassier Award for exceptional professional accomplishment. Yves Joanette is a Fellow of the Canadian Academy of Health Science. The Université Lumière de Lyon (France) presented him with an Honorary Doctorate.
